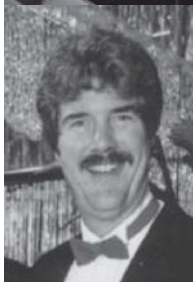

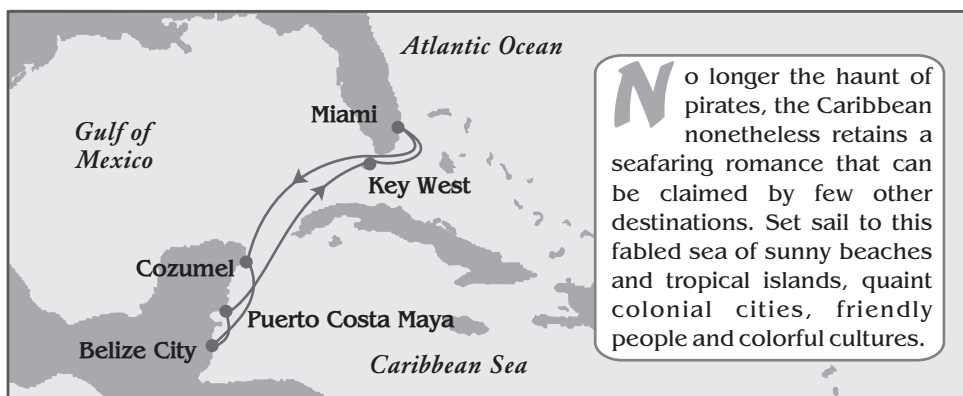

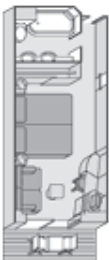

Cancellation fees for passengers, who cancel after that date for any reason, including medical or family reasons, are:
When cancelled after 09/12/07: 10% of invoice
When cancelled after 10/15/07: 50% of invoice
